

CHANGEOVER POINT | CANNING TOWN BUS STATION

Canning Town Bus Station at **BUS STAND**.

Always communicate in advance with iBus if you are late for any reason.







Route 69 is a high frequency route. Headway is a measurement of the distance or time between buses. You can tell that you are on the correct Headway by using the iBus Headway indicator in the cab.

IMPORTANT: You must keep your bus as close to the middle of the indicator as possible. Take action and drop back if you are closing in to the bus in front.




From Canning Town. Proceed from Walthamstow Central Bus Station direct to stand.

Set down in Walthamstow Central Bus Station at ALIGHTING POINT.

Towards Canning Town. Depart to Walthamstow Central Bus Station. Pick up in Walthamstow Central Bus Station at *BUS STOP A*.

Private stand for 13 buses in marked bays on east side of Walthamstow Central Bus Station on north side of Selborne Road. Overflow offside stand for 1 bus on west side of bus station in lay-by opposite Stop A.

Blind display: WALTHAMSTOW CENTRAL.

Turning point only - buses must not stand. **Blind display:** *LEYTON, BAKER ARMS.*



LEYTONCURTAILMENT POINT

TURNING POINT ONLY. BUSES MUST NOT STAND.

From Canning Town. Proceed from High Road Leyton via Grange Park Road, Church Road and High Road Leyton to stand. Set down on High Road Leyton at *BUS STOP N*.

Towards Canning Town. Depart to High Road Leyton. Pick up on High Road Leyton at *BUS STOP P*.

Public stand for two buses on east side of Leyton High Road. **Blind display:** *LEYTON, GRANGE PARK ROAD.*



From Walthamstow. Proceed from High Road Leyton via Private Bus Stand Grounds to stand. Set down on High Road Leyton at BUS STOP F.

Towards Canning Town. Depart via Stratford Bus Station, Stratford Bus Station and Great Eastern Road to The Grove. Pick up on The Grove at *BUS STOP R*.

From Walthamstow. Proceed from The Grove via Broadway, Great Eastern Road, Station Street, Stratford Bus Station and Stratford Bus Station to stand. Set down on The Grove at *BUS STOP R*.

Towards Walthamstow. Depart via Stratford Bus Station and Stratford Bus Station to Great Eastern Road. Pick up on Great Eastern Road at *BUS STOP P*.

Private stand for up to 14 buses facing north in Stratford Bus Station on west side of Great Eastern Road. **Blind display:** *STRATFORD*.



From Walthamstow. Proceed from Plaistow Road via Bull Road, Willis Road and Holbrook Road. Set down on Plaistow Road at *BUS STOP M*.

Towards Walthamstow. Depart to Plaistow Road. Pick up on Plaistow Road at *BUS STOP L*.

Turning point only - buses must not stand.

Blind display: PLAISTOW.


TURNING POINT ONLY. BUSES MUST NOT STAND.

Pick up on Hermit Road at BUS STOP T.



From Walthamstow. Proceed from Canning Town Bus Station direct to stand. Set down in Canning Town Bus Station at BUS STOP A.

Towards Walthamstow. Depart to Canning Town Bus Station. Pick up in Canning Town Bus Station at BUS STOP E.

Private stand for 2 buses in marked bays at rear stand on west side of Canning Town Bus Station at south-west corner of junction of Barking Road and Silvertown Way. Blind display: CANNING TOWN.



LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

VARIOUS HAZARDS | CANNING TOWN BUS STATION

Space for two buses to be parked on the offside. Risk of buses driving past. Drivers stepping off. Speed limit 10 mph. Approach parked buses with caution and take care when alighting as a high bus movement area. Hi vis jackets to be worn at all times whilst walking around the bus station.

BUSY BUS STOP | CANNING TOWN BUS STATION

Drivers are required to look/wait for intending passengers. Ensure the doors are clear before closing and moving off.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | CANNING TOWN BUS STATION

Danger of people stepping out without looking. Drivers need to exercise and caution and be on the lookout for pedestrians walking out in front of buses.

LOW BRIDGE | MANOR ROAD

Do not use Manor Road under any circumstances. There is a low bridge further along this road. Not suitable for double deck buses.

BOX JUNCTION | BARKING ROAD

Box junction on approach to Canning Town Bus Station. Drivers are advised that this junction box is live. Ensure that the whole bus can clear the junction.

BUSY BUS STOP | BARKING ROAD

Driver are required to look/wait for intending passengers. Ensure the doors are clear before closing and moving off.

TIGHT LEFT TURN | HERMIT ROAD

Tight left turn especially if vehicles go over the stop line. Exercise caution as vehicle regularly goes over the stop line.

BUS STAND | HERMIT ROAD CURTAILMENT

Drivers are reminded that the stand for Hermit Road is behind the McDonalds and must not use the 474 stand.

NARROW ROAD | HERMIT ROAD

Due to parked cars on either side, buses travel in both direction. Read road and plan. Work with large vehicles/buses heading in the opposite way.

LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

BLIND BEND | GRANGE ROAD / UPPER ROAD

Drivers advised to use extreme caution as buses use both directions.

NARROW ROAD | UPPER ROAD

Narrow road due to parked cars on either side, Exercise care and caution.

TIGHT LEFT TURN | UPPER ROAD / PLAISTOW ROAD

Tight left turn from Upper Road onto Plaistow Road. Risk of clipping kerb. Drivers are advised the when turning left, risk of mounting kerb.

PEDESTRIANS CROSSING | PLAISTOW ROAD

Danger of people crossing from behind cars. Exercise caution and be on the lookout for pedestrians walking out in front of buses.

TRAFFIC ISLAND | MANOR ROAD

Risk of collision with traffic island if bus does not get in the right lane. Driver advised to get in lane early to avoid contact with high kerb.

LOW BRIDGE | NEW PLAISTOW ROAD

Do not use Manor Road under any circumstances. There is a low bridge further along this road. Not suitable for double deck buses.

PEDESTRIANS CROSSING WEST HAM LANE

Danger of people crossing from behind cars. Driver needs to exercise caution and be on the lookout for pedestrians walking out in front of buses.

BUSY BUS STOP | TRAMWAY AVENUE

Risk of collision. Buses must merge into busy traffic. Care and caution when merging into main carriageway after serving bus stop especially during peak times.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | HIGH STREET

Pedestrians running across the junctions often without looking. Look/wait for intending passengers. Ensure the doors are clear before closing and moving off.

CYCLISTS | GREAT EASTERN ROAD

Very busy area with cycle lanes and cyclists. Risk of collision with cyclists and pedestrians. Care and caution and look out for cyclist merging for cycle lane.

LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

VARIOUS HAZARDS | BUS STATION (IF CURTAILED)

Offside parking on stand, risk of buses passing if you step off the bus or if you drive past a bus, a driver may step off. Approach parked buses with caution and take care when alighting in this high bus movement area. Hi vis jackets always to be worn whilst walking around the bus station.

NARROW ROAD | LEYTONSTONE RD/CROWNFIELD RD

Narrow road with cars parked. Risk of doors being opened and pedestrian crossing from behind parked vehicles. Drivers advised to exercise caution when driving through residential areas.

PEDESTRIANS CROSSING | HIGH ROAD LEYTON

Danger of people crossing from behind cars. Drivers need to exercise caution and be on the lookout for pedestrians walking out in front of buses.

LANE DISCIPLINE | CHURCH ROAD

Bus needs to merge with traffic on the right. Risk of collision during peak traffic times. Drivers advised to use care and caution when merging into main carriageway after serving bus stop especially during peak times.

BUS GARAGE | HIGH ROAD LEYTON / LEYTON GREEN RD

Leyton bus garage. Risk of road being blocked by buses returning to garage. Be aware of buses being parked, waiting to get into the bus garage.

NARROW ROAD | HIGH ROAD LEYTON / BAKERS ARMS

Bakers Arms curtailment. Drivers are advised that Bromley Road is a narrow road and exercise care when turning onto Capworth Street.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | HOE STREET

Danger of people crossing from behind cars. Driver needs to exercise caution and be on the lookout for pedestrians walking out in front of buses.

TIGHT LEFT TURN | WALTHAMSTOW CENTRAL BUS STN

Tight left turn when exiting the bus station into a contraflow bus lane. Take care when turning left into the contraflow and be aware that pedestrians may be looking the wrong way. Wear Hi Vis. 10 mph. Buses parked on offside.

CODE RED | EMERGENCY RADIO PROCEDURE

If you require the Emergency Services to attend your vehicle (for example in the event of passenger injury, assault or major RTA), you should contact CentreComm using the radio's Code Red facility. To call CentreComm, hold down the Code Red button on your vehicle's radio for at least 3 seconds until you hear a ringing tone to indicate that your call has been connected. Hold down the foot switch in the cab when you are speaking, and end what you have to say with the word "over" to indicate that you expect a response, or "over and out" if this is the end of your communication. Release the foot switch when you are not speaking. Remember to speak slowly and clearly. Note that you will usually receive a radio call from your depot shortly after you make a Code Red call. You should not use the radio whilst the vehicle is in motion.


