Towards Tooting. From stand, depart via Concert Hall Approach. Serve BUS STOP T.

Public stand for 3 buses in marked bays on north side of Concert Hall Approach. No more than 2 buses on Route 77 should be scheduled to stand at any one time. Blind display: WATERLOO.

**Towards Waterloo.** From stand, depart via Longley Road, Bickersteth Road and Renmuir Street to Mitcham Road. Pick up on Mitcham Road at *BUS STOP TD*.

Public stand for two buses on south side of Longley Road. **Blind display:** TOOTING STATION.



### **LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE**

Changeovers will take place on Wandsworth Road at **stop H** towards Waterloo or **stop M** towards Tooting.

Always communicate in advance with iBus if you are late for any reason.

### HEADER LIGHT AT SIGNAL | CONCERT HALL APPROACH

Towards Waterloo – proceed with caution when turning right onto York Road from traffic approaching from your left due to no header light on traffic signal.

### SPEED HUMPS AND COACHES | CHICHELEY STREET

Speed cushions and parked coaches. Drive over speed tables slowly. Be aware that this area is very busy with tourists and continental coaches often offload passengers onto the road.

### MULTIPLE LANES AND TAXIS | ADDINGTON STREET

When turning from York Road onto Addington Street, be aware of traffic in the other lane trying to speed ahead of you. Take the central lane in Addington Street in order to proceed to Lambeth Palace Road. Be aware that taxis queuing for Waterloo often cause lane restrictions at this location.

### LANES MERGE | LAMBETH PALACE ROAD

Towards Tooting, lane priority is unclear as two lanes from the east become one on the west. Be aware of other vehicle movements on both sides of you.

### NARROW LANES LAMBETH PALACE / COUNTY HALL

Towards Waterloo, be aware of traffic on your offside and the fact that County Hall was recently a roundabout and other traffic can suddenly change lanes.

### LOW BRIDGES | ALBERT EMBANKMENT

Except for Kennington Lane, there are low bridges on all roads to the south of Albert Embankment between Vauxhall and Lambeth Bridges. These roads must not be used by double deck vehicles.

### BUS GATE / TRAFFIC SIGNALS | ALBERT EMBANKMENT

Towards Tooting, traffic signals halt normal traffic to allow buses to continue through and to enter the bus lane on the offside to position for Vauxhall bus station.

### **LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE**

### BUS GATE / TRAFFIC SIGNALS | WANDSWORTH RD

Towards Waterloo, traffic signals halt normal traffic to allow buses to continue through and to enter the bus lane on the offside to position for Vauxhall bus station.

### MULTIPLE NARROW LANES | WANDSWORTH ROAD

Be aware of your road position and make good use of your mirrors. Be aware of poor lane discipline of other traffic.

### LIMITED VISIBILITY | VAUXHALL BUS STATION

The view of oncoming traffic can be obstructed by the blind box on 3xx series PVL type buses. Please take care that the road is clear before departing bus station and be aware of cyclists ignoring red pedestrian lights.

### TRAFFIC ISLANDS/SPEED TABLES | WANDSWORTH ROAD

Drive over speed tables slowly and with care to avoid injury to passengers and damage to the vehicle. Ensure there is enough road space to proceed.

### LOW BRIDGE | LAVENDER HILL / LATCHMERE ROAD

Do not enter Latchmere Road in a double deck vehicle under any circumstances.

### PEDESTRIANS | ST JOHN'S ROAD / LAVENDER HILL JUNC

Towards Waterloo, you often have to give way before turning right. By the time you cross the pedestrian crossing lane, their signal has often turned to green. Look out for pedestrians crossing who may focus on the green pedestrian signal as opposed to the location of your bus.

### VOLUME OF PEOPLE AND SPEED LIMIT ST JOHN'S ROAD

Take care when passing loading lorries, that there is no traffic approaching. Be careful to look out for pedestrians stepping into the path of the bus. Observe 20 mph speed limit.

### SIGNALS | ST JOHN'S ROAD / BATTERSEA RISE JUNCTION

Towards Tooting, Battersea Rise is often congested. You can get stuck in traffic on the junction when turning right from St John's Road. Be aware that the green pedestrian signal can sometimes come on whilst you are still trying to proceed into Battersea Rise.

### **LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE**

### PARKED VEHICLES | SPENCER PARK

Drive slowly and ensure that there is enough road space to proceed.

### LANES MERGING | WINDMILL ROAD

Take care, particularly towards Waterloo when crossing Trinity Road. Lane priority is unclear as two lanes from the west of the junction become one on the east. Be aware of other vehicle movements on both sides of you.

### LOW TREES | EARLSFIELD ROAD

Be aware of trees on the roadside, and use caution following rain or snowfall that can cause branches to hang lower or during events such as road works where you are forced to drive in a different part of the road to normal. Drive slowly and ensure that there is enough road space to proceed. Drive over speed tables slowly and with care to avoid poor ride quality, injury to passengers and damage to the vehicle.

### TIGHT LEFT TURN | EARLSFIELD ROAD / GARRATT LANE

Towards Tooting, take care with road positioning to ensure you avoid collision with kerb or oncoming traffic. Be aware that parked vehicles are often close to this corner, especially during evenings and Sundays.

### NARROW LANES | GARRATT LANE NEAR MAGDALEN RD

Towards Waterloo, you need to take the offside lane to turn right onto Earlsfield Road. Be aware of traffic squeezing through your nearside, especially when exercising the right turn manoeuvre.

### LIMITED PAVEMENT ACCESS | MITCHAM RD / FAIRLIGHT RD

Towards Waterloo, this stop has limited space. If another bus is serving the stop, you may need to hold back. Ensure you do not alight passengers onto the pavement that is inaccessible due to barriers.

### **VOLUME OF PEOPLE | MITCHAM ROAD**

Drive slowly and ensure there is enough road space to proceed. Be careful to look out for pedestrians stepping into the path of the bus. Drive over speed tables slowly and with care to avoid poor ride quality, injury to passengers and damage to the vehicle.

If you require the Emergency Services to attend your vehicle (for example in the event of passenger injury, assault or major RTA), you should contact CentreComm using the radio's Code Red facility. To call CentreComm, hold down the Code Red button on your vehicle's radio for at least 1 second until you hear a ringing tone to indicate that your call has been connected. Hold down the foot switch in the cab when you are speaking, and end what you have to say with the word "over" to indicate that you expect a response, or "over and out" if this is the end of your communication. Release the foot switch when you are not speaking. Remember to speak slowly and clearly. Note that you will usually receive a radio call from your depot shortly after you make a Code Red call. You should not use the radio whilst the vehicle is in motion.
