


CHANGEOVER | STOCKWELL PARK WALK

Stockwell Park Walk at BUS STAND.

Always communicate in advance with iBus if you are late for any reason.







Route 118 is a high frequency route. Headway is a measurement of the distance or time between buses. You can tell that you are on the correct Headway by using the iBus Headway indicator in the cab.

IMPORTANT: You must keep your bus as close to the middle of the indicator as possible. Take action and drop back if you are closing in to the bus in front.

From Morden. Proceed from Streatham Hill via Streatham Place and Atkins Road to stand. Set down on Streatham Hill at BUS STOP BS.

Towards Morden. Depart via Poynders Road, Atkins Road and Streatham Place to Streatham Hill. Pick up on Streatham Hill at BUS STOP BH.

Offside public stand on the north side of Atkins Road immediately west of the junction with Kings Avenue. **Blind display:** STREATHAM HILL CHRISTCHURCH ROAD.






MORDEN TERMINUS POINT

SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILST AT THE STAND

From Brixton. Proceed from Morden Station Forecourt direct to stand. Set down on Morden Station Forecourt at BUS STOP N.

Towards Brixton. Depart to London Road. Pick up on London Road at *BUS STOP C*.

Private stand for up to 8 buses on Morden Station Forecourt on north side of London Road. **Blind display:** MORDEN.



FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | STOCKWELL PARK WALK

Towards Morden from stand. Use filter light. Be aware of vehicles cutting in from the left, cyclists, and e-scooters. Pedestrians may walk on the road when it is not safe to do so.

TURNING RIGHT | STOCKWELL PARK WALK

Towards Brixton. Be aware of cyclists and e-scooters. Pedestrians may walk on the road when it is not safe to do so.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | BRIXTON ROAD

Narrow lanes, 20 mph. Proceed with care and caution particularly at weekends due to heavy pedestrian movement. Look out for cyclists and E-Scooters. Do not exceed the sign posted speed limit.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | BRIXTON UNDERGROUND STATION

Both directions. Shops, 20 mph. Proceed with care and caution particularly at weekends due to heavy pedestrian movement and pedestrians filtering across between vehicles. Do not exceed the sign posted speed limit.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | BRIXTON TOWN CENTRE

Both ways. Shops, 20 mph. Care and caution at all times, beware of pedestrians crossing the road in places other than designated areas, good use of mirrors required. Do not exceed the sign posted speed limit.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | BRIXTON RD / LAMBETH TOWN HALL

Towards Morden. Road layout, speed change to 30 mph. Use centre lane to proceed ahead. Check the offside mirror and blind spot ensuring this is clear before changing lanes. Look out for cyclists and e-scooters. There are several loading bays along the route be careful when pulling out from stops.

CYCLISTS AND E-SCOOTERS BRIXTON HILL

4 traffic lanes Lookout for cyclists and e-scooters. The road changes to 4 lanes making these very narrow. Prepare to give way if necessary to avoid a collision.

VARIOUS HAZARDS BRIXTON HILL / ARRIVA BUS GARAGE

Pedestrians crossing the road surrounded by heavy stationary traffic and parked vehicles. Be ready to slow down or stop if required for buses leaving or entering the garage. Carriage has minimum width due to cycle highway.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

VARIOUS HAZARDS | STREATHAM HILL

4 traffic lanes reduced to 3. Look out for cyclists and e-scooters. Prepare to give way if necessary to avoid a collision as vehicles may be unfamiliar with the road layout. Watch out for cars that are often parked in the loading bays.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | STREATHAM HILL STATION

Narrow Lanes. Watch your speed. Beware of pedestrians crossing away from designated crossing areas, be ready to slow down or stop if required. Look out for cyclists and e-scooters.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | STREATHAM HILL / S. HIGH ROAD

A23. Becmead Avenue. Odeon Cinema, parked vehicles. Look out for cyclists and e-scooters. Beware of pedestrians crossing away from designated crossing areas, be ready to slow down or stop if required. Watch out for cars that are often parked in the 24-hour parking bay.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | STREATHAM HIGH ROAD A23

St Leonard's Church. Road changes and branches into two directions. Keep left at the fork. Beware of pedestrians crossing away from designated crossing areas. Look out for cyclists and e-scooters.

CYCLISTS / E-SCOOTERS | STREATHAM STATION / TESCO

Look out for cyclists and e-scooters. Beware of pedestrians and shoppers crossing away from designated crossing areas.

PARKED VEHICLES | STREATHAM HIGH ROAD A23

Junction with Streatham Common North. Vehicles turning left. After serving Streatham United Reformed Church, please use the offside lane to proceed ahead. Beware of vehicles changing lanes to turn left. Look out for pedestrians, cyclists and e-scooters.

LANE DISCIPLINE | STREATHAM HIGH RD / GREYHOUND LN

Streatham High Road junction with Greyhound Lane. Traffic lights, 4 traffic lanes with two proceeding straight and 2 turning right. The road changes to 4 lanes making these very narrow. Straddle the right lanes or use the nearside lane when turning right. Prepare to give way if necessary to avoid a collision.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

PARKED VEHICLES | GREYHOUND LANE

20 mph, parked vehicles both sides of the road, speed humps. Reduce speed. Care and caution due to road layout. Watch out for cars that are often parked in the 24-hour parking bay.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | GREYHOUND LN / STREATHAM VALE

Streatham Common Station. 20 mph. Care and caution due to road layout. Look out for pedestrians, cyclists, and e-scooters.

SPEED HUMPS / 20 MPH | STREATHAM VALE

Parked vehicles, Parish church. Care and caution due to roundabout. Watch out for cars that are often parked close to stops (towards Brixton).

ROUNDABOUT | STREATHAM VALE / GREYHOUND TERR

Parked vehicles outside shop towards Brixton. Care and caution due to roundabout. Cars are often parked in the 24-hour parking bay.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | GREYHOUND TERRACE

Speed humps, 20mph, low trees. Reduce speed. Caution needs to be taken at and beware of overhanging trees.

SHARP LEFT TURN | ROWAN ROAD / GREYHOUND TERR

Bell on the left, Parked vehicles both sides of the road. Reduce speed. Caution needs to be taken always.

SPEED HUMPS / 20 MPH | ROWAN ROAD

Give way. Reduce speed. Caution needs to be taken. Be ready to give way.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | ROWAN ROAD / MANOR ROAD

Speed humps, 20 mph. Caution needs to be taken and beware of overhanging trees. Lookout for pedestrians, cyclists, and e-scooters.

GIVE WAY | MANOR ROAD

Reduce speed. Caution needs to be taken always. Be ready to give way.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

SHARP RIGHT TURN | ROWAN ROAD / MANOR ROAD

Reduce speed when turning right towards Morden. Reduce speed when turning right towards Brixton.

ROUNDABOUT | MANOR ROAD JUNC COMMONSIDE EAST

Reduce speed. Caution needs to be taken always when approaching all roundabouts. Busy junction.

LAMP POST COMMONSIDE EAST

Lamp post close to the kerb outside number 271. Reduce speed. Caution needs to be taken always when approaching this area and keep away from the kerb to prevent mirror collision with lamp post.

ROUNDABOUT UPPER GREEN EAST / COMMONSIDE WEST

Three Kings. Reduce speed. Caution needs to be taken always when approaching all roundabouts. Busy junction. Narrow bus lane. Reduce speed. Caution needs to be taken always when approaching roundabouts.

VARIOUS HAZARDS UPPER GREEN EAST

20 mph speed limit. Watch your speed. Beware of cyclists and pedestrians.

LEFT TURN | UPPER GREEN EAST JUNC LONDON ROAD

Sharp left turn at the traffic lights towards Morden, bell on the left. Reduce speed. Caution needs to be taken not to mount the kerb on the left.

NARROW LANES | LONDON ROAD JUNC LOWER GREEN

Narrow lanes at the traffic lights. Care and caution.

NARROW LANES | LONDON ROAD A217

Directly opposite Watermeads Nature Reserve. Care and caution when approaching zebra crossings. Be careful and look out for pedestrians and runners intending to use the crossing. Be prepared to stop for anyone stepping directly into the path of the bus. Observe the 20 mph speed limit.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | WANDLE ROAD JUNC LONDON ROAD

20 mph speed limit. Watch your speed. Be aware of cyclists. Sharp right turn towards Morden. Reduce speed. Caution needs to be taken not to mount the kerb on the right.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

FIRE STATION | LONDON ROAD A217

Parked vehicles on both sides. Be vigilant for emergency vehicles exiting the station and be ready to give way.

BLIND BEND | MORDEN ROAD JUNC WANDLE ROAD

Visibility reduced by blind bend both ways. Care and caution at all times, be aware of pedestrians crossing the road in places other than designated areas, good use of mirrors required.

BUSY ROUNDABOUT | MORDEN ROAD

Junction with Morden Hall Road, Bayham Road and St Helier Avenue.

Speeding vehicles. Reduce speed. Care and caution due to roundabout.

PARKED VEHICLES | ABERCONWAY ROAD

20 mph, parked vehicles both sides. Reduce speed. Watch out for cars that are often parked in the 24 hour parking bay.

RESTRICTED ENTRY | ABERCONWAY RD / LONDON ROAD

Restricted entry except buses. Watch out for motorists not familiar with the area you might have to reverse into the main road.

ROUNDABOUT | LONDON ROAD / MORDEN HALL ROAD

Speeding vehicles. Reduce speed. Care and caution and look out for cyclists and e-scooters. Keep to right lane when entering the roundabout towards Brixton.

BUS STOP 'C' | MORDEN STATION FORECOURT

Towards Brixton. Possible collision hazard. Extra care and caution when leaving the stop and pulling over to the right-hand lane. Look out for vehicles overtaking on the offside.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | MORDEN STATION FORECOURT

Stand, shops, congested pedestrian area. Other buses manoeuvring. Possible need to reverse vehicle to stand. Possible collision hazards Maximum speed of 10 mph. Be very careful of pedestrians stepping into path of the bus and other buses. Be aware of the bus station canopy when reversing.



CODE RED | EMERGENCY RADIO PROCEDURE

If you require the Emergency Services to attend your vehicle (for example in the event of passenger injury, assault or major RTA), you should contact CentreComm using the radio's Code Red facility. To call CentreComm, hold down the Code Red button on your vehicle's radio for at least 3 seconds until you hear a ringing tone to indicate that your call has been connected. Hold down the foot switch in the cab when you are speaking, and end what you have to say with the word "over" to indicate that you expect a response, or "over and out" if this is the end of your communication. Release the foot switch when you are not speaking. Remember to speak slowly and clearly. Note that you will usually receive a radio call from your depot shortly after you make a Code Red call. You should not use the radio whilst the vehicle is in motion.
