


CHANGEOVER | MORDEN STATION / TAMWORTH ROAD

Please read your duty card carefully for the changeover location:

At Morden Station or towards Crystal Palace. Tamworth Road at BUS STOP CR (Ruskin Road). Towards Morden Station. Tamworth Road at BUS STOP CJ (Ruskin Road). Always communicate in advance with iBus if you are late for any reason.







Route 157 is a high frequency route. Headway is a measurement of the distance or time between buses. You can tell that you are on the correct Headway by using the iBus Headway indicator in the cab.

IMPORTANT: You must keep your bus as close to the middle of the indicator as possible. Take action and drop back if you are closing in to the bus in front.

Towards Crystal Palace. Depart via Railway Approach Turning Circle, Railway Approach, Manor Road to Woodcote Road. Pick up on Woodcote Road at **BUS STOP J.**

Private stand for one bus on west side of station forecourt. **Blind display:** WALLINGTON.

From Morden Station. Proceed from Manor Road, Beddington Gardens, Shotfield to stand. Set down on Manor Road at *BUS STOP A*.





Towards Morden Station. Depart via Grosvenor Road, Belgrave Road, South Norwood High Street to Selhurst Road. Pick up on Selhurst Road at BUS STOP A.

Public stand for two buses on south side of Grosvenor Road (western arm). Blind display: NORWOOD JUNCTION.





From Morden Station. Proceed from Anerley Road, Anerley Station Road to stand. Set down on Anerley Road at BUS STOP AS.

Towards Morden Station. Depart via Anerley Station Road to Anerley Road. Pick up on Anerley Road at BUS STOP AC.

Private stand for 5 buses in Bus Parking Area on south side of Anerley Station Road approximately 100 metres north east of Minden Road. Blind display: ANERLEY STATION.



FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

BUS MOVEMENT | MORDEN STATION FORECOURT

Pedestrians. Use extra care and caution when driving through the tube station forecourt. Keep speed under 10 mph and watch out for pedestrians and buses manoeuvring.

MERGING TRAFFIC | MORDEN STATION EXIT

Merging with traffic on exit to station forecourt. Be prepared to give way to traffic on your offside when leaving the bus station.

LANE DISCIPLINE | MORDEN HALL ROAD

St Helier Avenue Roundabout, other vehicle movements. Maintain good lane discipline. Be aware of other vehicles beside the bus. Be prepared to give way.

PARKED VEHICLES | ST HELIER AVENUE

Vehicles parking close to carriageway edge. This is a 40 mph road, watch for vehicles ahead that may slow quickly to park in bay, vehicles will also pull out onto carriageway. Watch and be aware of car doors opening into carriageway. Be prepared to slow down or stop.

MULTIPLE LANES | ROSE HILL ROUNDABOUT

Other vehicle movements. Maintain good lane discipline. Be aware of other vehicles beside the bus. Be prepared to give way and be aware of other motorists changing lanes without warning.

NARROW ROAD | WRYTHE LANE SHOPPING PARADE

Road narrowed by parked vehicles. Look out for pedestrians crossing the road and vehicles emerging from parking bays. Be prepared to give way to oncoming vehicles where road narrows.

RECREATION GROUND | ST HELIER HOSPITAL

Pedestrian and vehicle movements. Ambulances emerging from Hospital. Children crossing to recreation ground. Use extra care and caution, watch your speed and be prepared to stop.

SCHOOL CHILDREN | WRYTHE LANE

Carshalton High School for girls Use extra care and caution. Watch your speed and beware of children crossing the road.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

PEDESTRIAN AREA | NORTH STREET

Carshalton College. Use extra care and caution. Watch your speed and beware of students crossing the road.

TIGHT LEFT TURN | NORTH STREET JUNC HIGH STREET

Very tight left turn (heading towards Crystal Palace). Be prepared to take a wide left turn and use some of the opposite carriageway when turning. Beware of oncoming vehicles.

HIGH BRICK WALL | HIGH STREET [CARSHALTON]

(Heading towards Morden). High brick wall on nearside leans into the road just before the junction. This narrow road is further restricted by a high brick wall on nearside which in places leans towards the road. Make full use of your mirrors, beware of oncoming vehicles and be prepared to give way.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | HIGH STREET [CARSHALTON]

Pedestrian and vehicle movements. Watch your speed, look out for pedestrians crossing and cars emerging from parking bays.

NARROW RESIDENTIAL ROAD | PARKGATE ROAD

Narrow residential road, parked vehicles. Watch your speed, look out for pedestrians crossing, make full use of your mirrors, beware of oncoming vehicles and be prepared to give way.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | RAILWAY APPROACH

Wallington Station (heading towards Morden). Vehicle movements. Watch your speed, look out for pedestrians crossing, make full use of your mirrors, beware of other buses manoeuvring and be prepared to give stop.

LIABLE TO FLOODING | MANOR ROAD

Road liable to flooding under railway bridge. Take extra care and caution after heavy rain as road sometimes becomes impassable.

PEDESTRIANS | MANOR ROAD / WOODCOTE ROAD

Stafford Road. Pedestrian and vehicle movements. Watch your speed, look out for pedestrians crossing and cars emerging from parking bays.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

ROAD JUNCTION | FIVE WAYS

Vehicle movements. Watch your speed, make full use of your mirrors, beware of other vehicles changing lane without warning. Be prepared to give way.

NARROW LANES | STAFFORD ROAD / EPSOM ROAD

Watch your speed, make full use of your mirrors, beware of other vehicles.

NARROW ROAD | EPSOM ROAD

Parked vehicles. Watch your speed, look out for pedestrians crossing, make full use of your mirrors, beware of oncoming vehicles and be prepared to give way.

TIGHT TURN | EPSOM ROAD JUNC WADDON NEW ROAD

Tight turn at junction. Watch your speed and make full use of your mirrors.

NARROW ROAD | WADDON NEW ROAD / RECTORY GROVE

Narrow residential road. Watch your speed, look out for pedestrians crossing and make full use of your mirrors.

FILTER LANE | ROMAN WAY / REEVES CORNER

(Heading towards Crystal Palace) Cross three lanes of traffic to take filter lane onto Reeves Corner. Use care and caution when changing lanes. Beware of faster vehicles approaching from behind and on your offside. Make full use of your mirrors, be prepared to give way.

TRAM MOVEMENTS | REEVES CORNER / TAMWORTH RD

Pedestrian and tram movements. Watch your speed, look out for pedestrians crossing, make full use of your mirrors. This road is shared with trams. Take extra caution. Be careful not to drive into tram only lanes.

TRAM MOVEMENTS | CHURCH STREET / CAIRO NEW ROAD

Reeves Corner (heading towards Morden). Pedestrian and tram movement. Watch your speed, look out for pedestrians crossing, make full use of your mirrors. This road is shared with trams. Take extra caution. Be careful not to drive into tram only lanes.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST



Pedestrian and tram and bus movements. Watch your speed, look out for pedestrians crossing, make full use of your mirrors. This road is shared with trams. Take extra caution. Be careful not to drive into tram only lanes.

NARROW ROAD | SOUTH NORWOOD HIGH STREET

Pedestrian and vehicle movements. Watch your speed, look out for pedestrians crossing, make full use of your mirrors.

PEDESTRIANS | CRYSTAL PALACE BUS STATION

Vehicle movements. Watch your speed, lookout for pedestrians crossing and other bus movements, make full use of your mirrors.

VERY TIGHT LEFT TURN | WESTOW HILL / CENTRAL HILL

Very tight left turn. Take a wide turn, use all the road available, take extra care and caution. Keep speed to dead slow.

NO LEFT TURN | MERTON BUS GARAGE

No left turn into bus garage from Merton High Street. Run light via Merantun Way, Christchurch Road, Priory Road and then turn right into the bus garage from Merton High Street.

CODE RED | EMERGENCY RADIO PROCEDURE

If you require the Emergency Services to attend your vehicle (for example in the event of passenger injury, assault or major RTA), you should contact CentreComm using the radio's Code Red facility. To call CentreComm, hold down the Code Red button on your vehicle's radio for at least 3 seconds until you hear a ringing tone to indicate that your call has been connected. Hold down the foot switch in the cab when you are speaking, and end what you have to say with the word "over" to indicate that you expect a response, or "over and out" if this is the end of your communication. Release the foot switch when you are not speaking. Remember to speak slowly and clearly. Note that you will usually receive a radio call from your depot shortly after you make a Code Red call. You should not use the radio whilst the vehicle is in motion.

Call CentreComm for non-emergency, incident reporting or diversions



Call CentreComm for emergency services, passenger injury or assault
