Route 212 is a high frequency route. Headway is a measurement of the distance or time between buses. You can tell that you are on the correct Headway by using the iBus Headway indicator in the cab.

IMPORTANT: You must keep your bus as close to the middle of the indicator as possible. Take action and drop back if you are closing in to the bus in front.



RUNNING OUT OF SERVICE

IMPORTANT LOG OFF IBUS IMMEDIATELY IF RUNNING LIGHT

TO CHINGFORD BUS STATION:

- From Northumberland Park garage, turn right onto Marsh Lane
- Turn right onto Marigold Road
- At traffic light, turn left onto Watermead Way A1055
- ♦ Continue ahead onto Angel Edmonton Road (under the North Circ) A1055
- At roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Conduit Lane
- Continue ahead onto Montagu Road
- At traffic light, turn left onto North Circular Road slip road
- Continue ahead onto Angel Road A406
- Exit North Circular Road towards Cooks Ferry Roundabout
- Keep on left lane and turn left onto Hall Lane A1009
- At roundabout, take 1st exit onto Waltham Way A1037
- At mini roundabout, take 1st exit onto Sewardstone Road A112
- At traffic light, turn right onto Kings Head Hill A110
- Continue ahead onto The Green A110
- At traffic light, turn left onto Station Road A1069
- Turn right into Chingford Bus Station to stand

FROM CHINGFORD BUS STATION:

- At *stand*, continue ahead and exit Chingford Bus Station
- Turn left onto Station Road A1069
- At junction, turn right onto The Green and continue onto Kings Head Hill A110
- At traffic light, turn left onto Sewardstone Road A112
- At mini roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Waltham Way A1037
- At mini roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Hall Lane A1009
- 🖕 At traffic light, turn right onto Walthamstow Avenue
- At Cooks Ferry roundabout, take 2nd exit onto North Circular Slip Road
- Join North Circular Road A406
- Exit North Circular Road and follow sign towards Tottenham A1055
- Continue ahead under North Circular Rd and follow sign to Brimsdown A1055
- At traffic light, turn right onto Montagu Road
- Continue ahead onto Conduit Lane
- At roundabout, take 1st exit onto Angel Edmonton Road (under the North Circ)
- Continue ahead onto Watermead Way to Northumberland Park garage

IMPORTANT LOG OFF IBUS IMMEDIATELY IF RUNNING LIGHT

TOWALTHAMSTOW ST. JAMES ST STATION:

- From Northumberland Park garage, turn right onto Marsh Lane
- Turn right onto Marigold Road
- At traffic light, turn right onto Watermead Way A1055
- Continue ahead onto Hale Road A1055
- At traffic light, turn left onto The Hale A1069
- At traffic light, continue ahead onto Ferry Lane (Tottenham Hale station on left)
- Continue ahead onto Forest Road A503
- At traffic light, turn right onto Blackhorse Road (Blackhorse Road stn on right)
- At traffic light, continue ahead onto St James Street A1006
- At roundabout, take 1st exit onto South Grove
- ♦ Turn left after the bridge onto Cranbrook Mews
- Continue ahead onto Courtenay Place to stand

FROM WALTHAMSTOW ST. JAMES ST STATION:

- At stand, continue ahead and exit bus stand via Courtenay Mews
- Continue ahead on Courtenay Place and continue onto Cranbrook Mews
- At junction, turn right onto South Grove (under railway bridge)
- At roundabout, take 2nd exit onto St James Street A1006
- At traffic light, continue ahead onto Blackhorse Road A1006
- At traffic light, turn left onto Forest Road (Blackhorse Road stn on left)
- Continue ahead onto Ferry Lane A503
- At traffic light, continue ahead onto The Hale A1069
- 🛉 At traffic light, turn right onto Hale Road **A1055**
- Continue ahead onto Watermead Way A1055
- At traffic light, turn left onto Marigold Road
- Turn left onto Marsh Lane to Northumberland Park garage

TO CHINGFORD BUS STATION:

- At stand, continue ahead and exit bus stand via Courtenay Mews
- Continue ahead on Courtenay Place and continue onto Cranbrook Mews
- At junction, turn left onto Selborne Road
- Turn left into Walthamstow Central Bus Station to serve station
- Exit Walthamstow Central Bus Station and turn left onto Selborne Road
- At traffic light, turn left onto Hoe Street A112
- At traffic light, turn right onto Church Hill
- At mini roundabout, take 1st exit onto Church Hill
- Continue ahead onto Prospect Hill
- At junction, turn left onto Shernhall Street
- At traffic light, turn right onto Forest Road A503
- At traffic light, turn left onto Fulbourne Road B160
- At roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Winchester Rd (over North Circular Rd) B160
- Continue ahead onto The Broadway B160
- At junction, turn left onto Larkshall Road (Highams Park Station) B160
- At roundabout, take 3rd exit onto New Road A1009
- Continue ahead onto Hatch Lane A1009
- At roundabout, take 1st exit onto Friday Hill B146
- At roundabout, take 1st exit onto Kings Road A110
- At traffic light, turn right onto Station Road A1069
- Turn right into Chingford Bus Station to stand

- At stand, continue ahead and exit Chingford Bus Station
- Turn left onto Station Road A1069
- At traffic light, turn left onto Kings Road A110
- At mini roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Friday Hill B146
- At roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Hatch Lane A1009
- Follow one-way system onto New Road via Hatch Lane A1009
- At roundabout, take 1st exit onto Larkshall Road B160
- Turn right onto The Broadway B160
- Continue ahead onto Winchester Road B160
- At roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Fulbourne Road (over North Circular Rd) B160
- At traffic light, turn right onto Forest Road A503
- At traffic light, turn left onto Shernhall Street
- Turn right onto Prospect Hill
- Continue ahead onto Church Hill
- At mini roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Church Hill
- At traffic light, turn left onto Hoe Street A112
- Keep right and at traffic light, turn right onto Selborne Road
- Turn right into Walthamstow Central Bus Station to serve station
- Exit Walthamstow Central Bus Station and turn right onto Selborne Road
- Follow road left before the bridge and turn right onto Cranbrook Mews
- Continue ahead onto Courtenay Place to stand


TERMINUS POINT

SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILST AT THE STAND

From Walthamstow. Proceed from Chingford Bus Station direct to stand. Set down in Chingford Bus Station at **BUS STOP B**.

Towards Walthamstow. Depart to Chingford Bus Station. Pick up in Chingford Bus Station at **BUS STOP B**.

Private stand for 3 buses at Stop B in Chingford Bus Station on south side of Station Road. No more than 1 bus on Route 212 should be scheduled to stand at any one time. **Blind display:** CHINGFORD STATION.


TURNING POINT

From Walthamstow. Proceed from Hatch Lane via Chingford Lane. Set down on Hatch Lane at BUS STOP HH.

Towards Walthamstow. Depart to Hatch Lane. Pick up on Hatch Lane at *BUS STOP HS*.

Turning point only - buses must not stand. Blind display: CHINGFORD HATCH.




HIGHAMS PARK STATION CURTAILMENT POINT

IMPORTANT PLEASE ENSURE YOU USE YOUR **RIBAS KEY**ON **EVERYTRIP**

From Walthamstow. Proceed from The Broadway via Larkshall Road, Hickman Avenue, Jubilee Avenue and Larkshall Road. Set down on The Broadway at BUS STOP WR.

Towards Walthamstow. Depart to The Broadway. Pick up on The Broadway at BUS STOP WG.

Turning point only - buses must not stand. Blind display: HIGHAMS PARK.

From Chingford Station. Proceed from Fulbourne Road via Forest Road, Woodford New Road and Waterworks Corner roundabout. Set down on Fulbourne Road at **BUS STOP WOOD STREET LIBRARY**.

Towards Chingford Station. Depart to Woodford New Road and Forest Road. Pick up on Fulbourne Road at *BUS STOP CLIFFORD ROAD*.

From Walthamstow. Proceed from Fulbourne Rd via Forest Rd, Woodford New Rd and Waterworks Corner roundabout. Set down on Forest Rd at **BUS STOP BQ**.

Towards Walthamstow. Depart to Woodford New Road and Forest Road. Pick up on Forest Road at *BUS STOP BS*.

Turning point only. Blind display: WALTHAMSTOW, BEACONTREE AVENUE.



From Chingford Station. Proceed from Walthamstow Central Bus Station direct to stand. Set down in Walthamstow Central Bus Station at *ALIGHTING POINT WALTHAMSTOW BUS STATION*.

Towards Chingford Station. Depart to Walthamstow Central Bus Station. Pick up in Walthamstow Central Bus Station at *BUS STOP D*.

Private stand for 13 buses in marked bays on east side of Walthamstow Central Bus Station on north side of Selborne Road. Overflow offside stand for 1 bus on west side of bus station in lay-by opposite Stop A.

Blind display: WALTHAMSTOW CENTRAL.




ST. JAMES STREET STN TURNING POINT

From Chingford Station. Proceed from Courtenay Place via Bus Parking Area to stand. Set down on Courtenay Place at BUS STOP F.

Towards Chingford Station. Depart via Bus Parking Area and Courtenay Mews to Courtenay Place. Pick up on Courtenay Place at BUS STOP E.

Private stand for 6 buses in Bus Parking Area on south side of Courtenay Mews. Blind display: ST JAMES STREET.

LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

CHANGEOVER | SELBORNE ROAD, WALTHAMSTOW

Changeovers will take place on Selborne Road at **Stand R** (Walthamstow Central) towards Chingford and **Stop W** (Walthamstow Central) towards St. James Street. **Communicate in advance with iBus if you are late for any reason.**

NARROW ROAD COURTENAY PLACE

Maximum speed on approach should be 5 mph. Proceed dead slow and be observant for pedestrian movements and drivers stepping off the bus. Hi-vis jackets to be worn when off the bus and around the stand.

SPEED TABLES | SELBORNE ROAD

Exercise extreme care and caution. Keep speed to a minimum. Position carefully when negotiating the speed tables and avoid late braking.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | WALTHAMSTOW BUS STATION

Very busy station, high volume of vehicles and pedestrians. Risk of collision with pedestrians when entering and exiting the station if planning ahead is not maintained and mirrors not checked: Maximum speed is 10 MPH.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | HOE STREET

High volume of pedestrian movements. Double parking. Negotiate with care and be aware of pedestrian movements emerging from all directions and in between poorly parked vehicles.

SPEED BUMPS CHURCH HILL

Narrow road, use of appropriate speed. Avoid late braking. Be observant of large crowds on pavements or at bus stops, especially during school times.

SPEED BUMPS | SHERNHALL STREET

Schools and hospital. Use of appropriate speed, avoid late braking. Be observant of large crowds on pavements or at bus stops, especially during school times. Position carefully when traversing the speed bumps.

CYCLE LANE | FOREST ROAD

Waltham Forest College. Be observant of large crowds on pavements or at bus stops, especially during school times. Position carefully when overtaking cyclists. Be aware of cyclists overtaking and undertaking the bus.

LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

NARROW ROAD | FULBOURNE ROAD

Double parking, speed bumps. Be aware that oncoming traffic may use part of your carriageway. Use of appropriate speed is needed and avoid late braking on the approach to the speed humps.

SCHOOL CHILDREN | WINCHESTER ROAD

School. Speed bumps. Exercise extreme care and caution. Be observant of large crowds on pavements or at bus stops, especially during school times. Keep speed to a minimum. Position carefully when negotiating the speed tables and avoid late braking.

LOW TREES | SELWYN AVENUE

Care and caution. Please be aware and report any low hanging branches especially through seasons with general tree growth.

VOLUME OF PEDESTRIANS | LARKSHALL ROAD

High volume of pedestrian and vehicle movements. Level crossing, cyclists and schools. Negotiate with care and be observant of a high volume of pedestrian and vehicle movements. Be aware of cyclists overtaking and undertaking the bus. Report any near misses.

SPEED TABLES | KINGS ROAD

Use of appropriate speed. Avoid late braking. Take extra care and caution when traversing the speed tables.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | STATION ROAD

Busy high street. High number of pedestrians. High number of vehicle movements. School. Take extra care and caution with speed kept to a minimum. Be vigilant of pedestrians emerging from all directions and in between parked vehicles. Be observant of large crowds on pavements or at bus stops, especially during school times.

VOLUME OF PEDESTRIANS | CHINGFORD BUS STATION

High volume of pedestrians and vehicle movements. Exercise extreme care and caution. Keep speed to a minimum. Be observant of a high volume of vehicles and pedestrians around you.

CODE RED | EMERGENCY RADIO PROCEDURE

If you require the Emergency Services to attend your vehicle (for example in the event of passenger injury, assault or major RTA), you should contact CentreComm using the radio's Code Red facility. To call CentreComm, hold down the Code Red button on your vehicle's radio for at least 3 seconds until you hear a ringing tone to indicate that your call has been connected. Hold down the foot switch in the cab when you are speaking, and end what you have to say with the word "over" to indicate that you expect a response, or "over and out" if this is the end of your communication. Release the foot switch when you are not speaking. Remember to speak slowly and clearly. Note that you will usually receive a radio call from your depot shortly after you make a Code Red call. You should not use the radio whilst the vehicle is in motion.
