Bus checks

Pre-service

Remember if you take any bus out of the garage, you **MUST** complete your pre-service check, the 10-point check and sign your log card to confirm this. This is a legal requirement.

Stand check

Each time you reach a stand and are not departing immediately you **MUST** check your bus for defects and lost property. If you are on a "Road Stand" you will not be required to check the outside of the vehicle which is in the traffic flow.

Post-service

If you are the last person to drive a bus on that day you **MUST** check your bus prior to leaving it to be fuelled and washed. You **MUST** then sign your bus off on the "Defect Report Sheet" stating whether your bus has any defect.

Your duty card will say "BUS FINISHED" to indicate you MUST sign the bus off.

NEEDLES

If during your checks you find a discarded needle, **DO NOT TOUCH IT,** notify an Engineer, Supervisor or call the controller if you are on the road. If you do puncture the skin with a needle or syringe seek medical attention immediately.



PEDESTRIANS.

Clapham Junction is a very busy area with commuters and shoppers. Extra care when driving in this area as many people will be rushing to get to or from their destination and not paying full attention to passing traffic.

CYCLIST. In the last few years we have seen a significant increase in the use of cycles. This is not going to change and the likelihood of an even greater number is expected.

You MUST think cycle every time you move off, change lanes, change direction, turn left or right and when pulling up at bus stops.

Remember, a slight "touch" of cyclist could be very a very serious incident.



PARKING.

Along this route you will come across this hazard. Avoid the use of excessive steering as this will cause your rear overhang to swing and could hit a parked vehicle or street furniture. Wherever possible try to ensure that the traffic you meet in these situations do most of the manoeuvring.

GARAGE JOURNEYS

PUTNEY GARAGE TO RICHMOND BUS STATION: From Garage via Chelverton Road, Putney High Street, Upper Richmond Road, Upper Richmond Road West, Sheen Road, Paradise Road, Church Terrace, Wakefield Road to Richmond Bus Station.. Pick up in Richmond Bus Station at Stop H. Display "NOT IN SERVICE" to Stop H then appropriate destination.

PUTNEY GARAGE TO CLAPHAM JUNCTION, Bolingbroke Grove

Garage via Chelverton Road, Putney High Street, Upper Richmond Road, West Hill, Putney Bridge Road, Armoury Way Fairfield Street, East Hill, Marcilly Road, North Side Wandsworth Common and Battersea Rise. Pick up in Battersea Rise at Stop X. Display "NOT IN SERVICE" to Stop X then appropriate destination.

CLAPHAM JUNCTION TO PUTNEY GARAGE: From Battersea Rise stop "SC" via North Side Wandsworth Common, East Hill, Wandsworth High Street, West Hill, Tibbet's Corner, Tibbet's Ride, Putney Hill, Putney High Street and Chelverton Road to Garage. Set down in Battersea Rise at bus stop "SC". Display Clapham Junction to Battersea Rise then "NOT IN SERVICE" to Garage.

RICHMOND BUS STATION TO PUTNEY GARAGE: From Richmond Bus Station via Wakefield Road, Lewis Road, Red Lion Street, Hill Street, George Street, The Square, Sheen Road, Upper Richmond Road West, Upper Richmond Road, Putney High Street, and Chelverton Road to Garage. Set down in Richmond Bus Station Sop H. Display "RICHMOND" to Richmond Bus Station then "NOT IN SERVICE" to Garage.

STANDS AND TURNING POINTS:

<u>Clapham Junction, Bolingbroke</u> <u>Grove.</u>

Buses proceed from Battersea Rise via Bolingbroke Grove to stand, departing to Bolingbroke Grove and boutflower Road to Battersea Rise.

Last stop: Battersea Rise, stop SC First stop: Battersea Rise, stop X

Blind Display: CLAPHAM JUNCTION



Wandsworth, Ram Street From Richmond

Buses proceed from Armoury Way via Ram Street to stand, departing Ram Street to Wandsworth High Street.

Last stop: Armoury Way, stop E
First stop: Wandsworth High Str, stop Y



Wandsworth High Street. Multi Lanes.

Ensure you gain the correct position (Lane) as soon as possible as Wandsworth High Street can get extremely busy and changing lanes can be challenging especially at any junction.



Street Furniture -Traffic bells

Along the route and at some turning points you will see these Traffic bells or other street furniture close to the kerb edge on a corner. They are designed to stop vehicles mounting the kerb and coming into conflict with pedestrians. Take your time and watch your mirrors. They can cause large amount of damage to the bus if contact is made.

Tight Right Turn

Battersea Rise into Bolingbroke Road

This right turn can be made extremely difficult if the traffic waiting in Bolingbroke Road has stopped beyond the first stop line. DO NOT rush this turn, good observation, mirror work, steering and gas control is required to negotiate this corner safely.



Emergency Services West Hill, Wandsworth

West Hill has a Fire Station and Ambulance Station located opposite each other. Please be vigilant and aware that you may hear sirens at any time when approaching

Buses proceed from Upper Richmond Road via Putney Hill, Putney Heath and Bus Standing Area, departing via Bus Standing Area and Putney Hill to Upper Richmond Road.

Last Stop: Upper Richmond Road, stop JA First Stop: Upper Richmond Road, stop JB



Putney Garage, from Richmond

As an alternative to travelling to Putney Heath from Richmond you can use Putney Garage to turn and stand at certain times.

Monday to Friday: After 07:30 and before 18:30

Weekends and bank holidays: After 11:30 and before 17:30

Public stand for one bus on Queen's Ride.

Buses proceed from Upper Richmond Road via Queens Ride to stand, departing via Queen's Ride, Queen's slip road to Upper Richmond Road.

Last Stop: Upper Richmond Road, stop K First Stop: Upper Richmond Road, stop F

Barnes Common, Queens Ride From Richmond


Public stand for one bus on Queen's Ride.

Buses proceed from Upper Richmond Road via Queens Ride to stand, departing via Queen's Ride, Queen's slip road to Upper Richmond Road.

Last Stop: Upper Richmond Road, stop E
First Stop: Upper Richmond Road, stop M

East Sheen, Black Horse From Clapham Junction

Public stand for two bus on west side Queen's Road.

Buses proceed from Upper Richmond Road West via Sheen Road and Queen's Road to stand, departing via Queen's Road to Sheen Road.

Last Stop: Upper Richmond Road West, stop Z

First Stop: Sheen Road, stop SD

Blind Display: EAST SHEEN, Queen's Road

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES – Closure of garage/Chelverton Road

In the event that Putney Garage/Chelverton Road/Putney High Street being closed for any reason it will become necessary to find alternative arrangements to park our buses for a period of time or until the situation changes.

The Location of this alternative parking is the bus lane along Tibbet's Ride.





As this is a public area it is very important that you leave the vehicle in as safe a condition as is possible.

- Ensure the engine is off
- Ensure the handbrake is on
- Turn the engine off
- Isolate the electrics
- Ensure all doors and windows are closed

As this is also a hill it is good practice to have the steering wheels pointing slightly inwards towards the kerb.
