IMPORTANT: Please do your utmost to keep your bus within this 7 minute window unless prevented by traffic or other circumstances beyond your control. A few seconds make a big difference to our performance.





Route 357 Whipps Cross new junction layout

Please familiarise yourself with the new road layout which replaced Whipps Cross roundabout. Buses enter the terminus via Lea Bridge Road and Whipps Cross Road. Buses must turn left when exiting the terminus.

Please use extra care and caution at all times.


SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILST AT THE STAND

From Whipps Cross. Proceed from Hatch Lane direct to stand. Set down on Hatch Lane at **BUS STOP HH.**

Towards Whipps Cross. Depart via Hatch Lane, Friday Hill and Friday Hill West to Friday Hill. Pick up on Friday Hill at *BUS STOP HM*.

Public stand for 1 bus on north side of Hatch Lane. No more than 1 bus on Route 357 should be scheduled to stand at any one time.


CURTAILMENT POINT

TURNING POINT ONLY. **BUSES MUST NOT** STAND.

From Whipps Cross. Proceed from Chingford Mount Road via Old Church Road and Albert Crescent to stand. Set down on Chingford Mount Road at BUS STOP L.

Towards Whipps Cross. Depart via Albert Crescent and Hall Lane to Chingford Mount Road. Pick up on Chingford Mount Road at BUS STOP J.

Public stand for 4 buses in marked bays on south side of Albert Crescent. Blind display: CHINGFORD MOUNT.




WALTHAMSTOW TURNING POINT

TURNING POINT ONLY. BUSES MUST NOT STAND.

From Whipps Cross. Proceed from Chingford Road via Crooked Billet Roundabout. Set down on Chingford Road at **BUS STOP CH**.

Towards Whipps Cross. Depart to Chingford Road. Pick up on Chingford Road at *BUS STOP CE*.

Turning point only - buses must not stand. Blind display: WALTHAMSTOW, CROOKED BILLET



WALTHAMSTOW CENTRAL

CURTAILMENT POINT

SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILST AT THE STAND

From Chingford Hatch. Proceed from Hoe Street via Selborne Road and Walthamstow Central Bus Station to stand. Set down in Walthamstow Central Bus Station at ALIGHTING POINT.

Towards Chingford Hatch. Depart via Walthamstow Central Bus Station and Selborne Road to Hoe Street. Pick up on Hoe Street at **BUS STOP G**.

From Whipps Cross. Proceed from Hoe Street via Selborne Road and Walthamstow Central Bus Station to stand. Set down in Walthamstow Central Bus Station at *ALIGHTING POINT*.

Towards Whipps Cross. Depart via Walthamstow Central Bus Station and Selborne Road to Hoe Street. Pick up on Hoe Street at *BUS STOP V*.

Private stand for 13 buses in marked bays on east side of Walthamstow Central Bus Station. Blind display: WALTHAMSTOW CENTRAL.



LEYTONTURNING POINT

TURNING POINT ONLY. BUSES MUST NOT STAND.

From Chingford Hatch. Proceed from Hoe Street via High Road Leyton, Leyton Green Road and High Road Leyton. Set down on Hoe Street at *BUS STOP SK*.

Towards Chingford Hatch. Depart to Hoe Street. Pick up on Hoe Street at *BUS STOP NH*.

Turning point only - buses must not stand. Blind display: LEYTON, BAKERS ARMS.



WHIPPS CROSS

TERMINUS POINT - MON TO SAT ONLY


PLEASE CHECK TRIP NUMBER ON ETM BEFORE DEPARTING

From Chingford Hatch. Proceed from Whipps Cross Bus-Only Facility direct to stand. Set down in Whipps Cross Bus-only Facility at **BUS STOP F**.

Towards Chingford Hatch. Depart to Whipps Cross Bus-Only Facility. Pick up in Whipps Cross Bus-only Facility at *BUS STOP NH*.

Towards Whipps Cross Hospital. Turn right from Lea Bridge Road into Whipps Cross Bus-Only Facility, serve bus stop on the east side. (*Green route below*).

Stand on west side of new bus-only facility connecting Whipps Cross Road and Lea Bridge Road. **Blind display:** WHIPPS CROSS.


TERMINUS POINT - SUNDAY ONLY

SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILST AT THE STAND

From Chingford Hatch. Proceed from Hospital Road in Whipps Cross Hospital Grounds via James Lane, Whipps Cross Road, James Lane and Hospital Road to stand. Set down on Hospital Road in Whipps Cross Hospital Grounds at <u>BUS STOP L</u>.

Towards Chingford Hatch. Depart to Hospital Road in Whipps Cross Hospital Grounds. Pick up on Hospital Road at BUS STOP N.

Private stand in bay on east side of private road in hospital grounds. Blind display: WHIPPS CROSS HOSPITAL.



LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

CHANGEOVER | HOE STREET

Changeovers will take place on Hoe Street at **Stop V** (Walthamstow Central) towards Whipps Cross and **Stop W** (Walthamstow Central) towards Chingford Hatch, both on the railway bridge. **Always communicate in advance** with iBus if you are late for any reason.

NARROW ROAD | NEW ROAD/CHINGFORD HATCH

Narrow Road due to indiscriminate parking: Larkswood Primary School also causing the road to be very congested and risk of collision with parked cars during school pick up drop off times: Road humps and platforms at crossing points. Look well ahead to avoid meeting large oncoming vehicles. Reduce speed accordingly when in preparation to traverse the speed humps. Avoid late braking and report any near misses as new road is an accident hot spot.

TIGHT TURN | FRIDAY HILL EAST/CHIGDALE ROAD

Slip road into Friday Hill East: tight turn: narrow road. Minimum speed, plan ahead position bus and proceed with extreme care and caution. Keep an eye on the tail swing.

TIGHT LEFT TURN | CHINGFORD MOUNT JUNCTION

Pedestrian crossing: low trees: cycle lane either side or high number of pedestrian movements: yellow box junction. Plan ahead and position yourself in preparation to make the tight left turn. Watch out for pedestrians crossing and cyclists on the nearside attempting the tight left turn. Mirrors constantly to be used. Be vigilant of low, over hanging trees and the live yellow box junction.

LANE POSITIONING | CROOKED BILLET ROUNDABOUT

Traverse the roundabout slowly and be careful to select the correct road position to allow enough space for the rear tail end. Mirrors to be used continuously.

CYCLISTS | CHINGFORD ROAD

Sir George Monoux College. Groups of youths around the area often messing about paying little attention to their surroundings. Cycle lanes either side. Exercise extreme care and caution, keep speed to a minimum and report any near misses. Be extra vigilant of cyclists undertaking the bus. Mirrors to be used continuously in this area.

LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

VOLUME OF PEDESTRIANS | HOE STREET

Indiscriminate parking causing lane narrowing. Cycle lane, speed table, overhanging trees, refuge island and a high number of pedestrian movements. Look well ahead to avoid meeting large oncoming vehicles. Be extra vigilant of cyclists undertaking the bus. Mirrors to be used continuously. Traverse the speed tables with extreme care and caution and avoid late braking. Be vigilant of low over hanging trees. Be vigilant of pedestrian movements and pedestrians on refuge islands.

YELLOW BOX JUNCTION | HOE STREET

Yellow box junction and Barclay Primary School. Only proceed if the road ahead is clear to avoid getting caught in the yellow box junction. Use of appropriate speed and be observant of the high volume of children around school times.

BUS STATION 10MPH | WALTHAMSTOW CENTRAL

Adverse cambers on exit of station. Pedestrian crossings (zebra and pelican), other bus manoeuvres and barriers. Offside bus stands in bus station. Moving across from bus stand to pick up stop. Use of Hi-Vis when around the bus station. Ensure your speed is no more than 10 MPH. Keep a sharp eye for pedestrians emerging from all directions when leaving the bus stop. Reduce speed to a minimum when exiting the bus stand and position carefully to avoid collision with bell on exit.

TIGHT LEFT TURN | BAKERS ARMS

Indiscriminate parking causing lane narrowing. Shops in area and large congregation of pedestrians. Minimum speed, plan ahead, position bus and proceed with extreme care and caution when making the sharp left turn, keep an eye on the tail swing. Look ahead to avoid meeting large vehicles coming the other way. Be observant of pedestrians emerging from all directions.

NARROW ROAD BAKERS ARMS JUNC LEYTON GREEN RD

Narrow lanes. Be sure to check your mirrors and plan ahead. Be observant that oncoming traffic may use part of your carriageway.

LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

VOLUME OF PEDESTRIANS | LEA BRIDGE ROAD

Indiscriminate parking causing lane narrowing. Shops in area and large congregation of pedestrians. Cycle lane either side. Speed tables and high number of pedestrian movements. Look ahead to avoid meeting large oncoming vehicles. Be extra vigilant of cyclists undertaking the bus. Mirrors to be used continuously. Traverse the speed tables with extreme care and caution. Avoid late braking and be vigilant of pedestrians emerging from all directions.

SPEED CAMERAS | LEA BRIDGE ROAD

Maximum speed should be 30 MPH.

NEW TERMINUS | WHIPPS CROSS BUS FACILITY

Use extra care and caution at all times when using the new signalised T-junction which has replaced the old roundabout. Towards Whipps Cross from Lea Bridge Road, turn right onto Whipps Cross Road and then right into the buses only section: Stand on the front stand: Stop on the left hand side. Towards Whipps Cross Sundays From Lea Bridge Road, turn right into buses only section, serve the new stop on the east side towards the hospital. Towards Hatch Lane, when departing the bus stand/stop, turn left onto Lea Bridge Road.

LOW HEIGHT CLEARANCE | WHIPPS CROSS HOSPITAL

Low bridge inside hospital. Max Height 14'5". 10'2 height restriction refers to an ambulance only road near the x-ray department at the rear of the hospital. High volume of pedestrian movements. **No double deck vehicles to be allocated to route 357 on Sundays.** Do not use enter the car park via the no entry to serve the first stop. Please continue along Hospital Road, left onto James Lane, right Whipps Cross Road, right James Lane and right onto Hospital Road.

CARE AND CAUTION | SCHOOLS ENROUTE

Sir George Monoux College, Chingford Road, Leyton Sixth Form College, Lime Academy Larkswood and Barclay Primary School. Be aware of crowds on the pavement or at bus stops at appropriate times of the day.

CODE RED | EMERGENCY RADIO PROCEDURE

If you require the emergency services to attend your vehicle (for example in the event of passenger injury, assault or major RTA), you should contact CentreComm using the radio's Code Red facility. To call CentreComm, hold down the Code Red button on your vehicle's radio for at least 3 seconds until you hear a ringing tone to indicate that your call has been connected. Hold down the foot switch in the cab when you are speaking, and end what you have to say with the word "over" to indicate that you expect a response, or "over and out" if this is the end of your communication. Release the foot switch when you are not speaking. Remember to speak slowly and clearly. Note that you will usually receive a radio call from your depot shortly after you make a Code Red call. You should not use the radio whilst the vehicle is in motion.
