



THINGS TO REMEMBER MAKE NOTES ALONG THE WAY!

CHANGEOVER POINT | RIVER ROAD

River Road at **BUS STOP R** (Thames Road) towards Barking Riverside. River Road at **BUS STOP** (Thames Road) towards Little Heath. Always communicate in advance with iBus if you are late for any reason.

Route EL3 is a high frequency route. Headway is a measurement of the distance or time between buses. You can tell that you are on the correct Headway by using the iBus Headway indicator in the cab.

IMPORTANT: You must keep your bus as close to the middle of the indicator as possible. Take action and drop back if you are closing in to the bus in front.





RUNNING OUT OF SERVICE

IMPORTANT LOG OFF IBUS IMMEDIATELY IF RUNNING LIGHT

TO BARKING RIVERSIDE NORTHGATE ROAD:

- From River Road garage, turn left onto River Road
- Continue ahead onto River Road (to join line of route)
- Turn right onto Fielders Crescent and follow the road to the left
- Continue ahead on Fielders Crescent (past Riverside Campus)
- Follow the road left onto Northgate Road
- Turn right onto Barking Riverside bus stand to stand

FROM BARKING RIVERSIDE NORTHGATE ROAD:

- At stand, exit and turn left onto Northgate Road
- Follow the road to the right onto Fielders Crescent (past Riverside Campus)
- At junction, turn left onto River Road
- Continue ahead on River Road
- Turn right into River Road garage

TO BARKING RIVERSIDE MALLARDS ROAD:

- From *River Road garage*, turn right onto River Road
- 🖕 At traffic light, turn right onto Thames Road
- Turn right onto Marine Drive
- At roundabout, take 3rd exit onto Galleons Drive
- Turn left onto Marine Drive to stand

FROM BARKING RIVERSIDE MALLARDS ROAD:

- At stand, exit and turn left onto Marine Drive
- Turn right onto Mallards Road
- At junction, turn right onto Galleons Drive
- At roundabout, take 1st exit onto Marine Drive
- At traffic light, turn left onto Thames Road
- Turn left onto Creek Road and at junction, turn right onto Long Reach Road
- At junction, turn right onto River Road to River Road garage

- At Lodge Avenue roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Lodge Avenue A1153
- At mini-roundabout, take 1st exit onto Lodge Avenue
- At traffic light, turn left onto Longbridge Road A124
- Turn right onto Goodmayes Lane **B177**
- At mini roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Goodmayes Lane B177


LITTLE HEATH TERMINUS POINT

SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILST AT THE STAND

From Barking Riverside. Proceed from Barley Lane direct to stand. Set down on Barley Lane at **BUS STOP B**.

Towards Barking Riverside. Depart to Barley Lane. Pick up on Barley Lane at *BUS STOP B*.

Public stand for one bus in bay on west side of Barley Lane on the west side of The Green. **Blind display:** LITTLE HEATH.



Turning point only - buses must not stand. Blind display: KING GEORGE HOSPITAL.

Set down on Goodmayes Lane at **BUS STOP J**.

Towards Barking Riverside. Depart to Goodmayes Lane.


Pick up on Goodmayes Lane at BUS STOP K.

From Little Heath. Proceed from Goodmayes Road via Green Lane, Mayfield Road, Greenside and Green Lane. Set down on Goodmayes Road at **BUS STOP F.**

Towards Little Heath. Depart to Goodmayes Road.

Pick up on Goodmayes Road at BUS STOP E.

Turning point only. Blind display: GOODMAYES, GOODMAYES LANE..



BARKING CURTAILMENT POINT

IMPORTANT PLEASE ENSURE YOU USE YOUR RIBAS KEY ON EVERYTRIP

From Little Heath. Proceed from Station Parade via London Road and London Road Bus Stand to stand.

Set down on London Road at BUS STOP C.

Towards Little Heath. Depart via London Road Bus Stand to London Road. Pick up on London Road at **BUS STOP E**.

Private stand for nine buses in bus parking area on north side of London Road. **Blind display: BARKING**.




BARKING STATION CURTAILMENT POINT

TURNING POINT ONLY. **BUSES MUST NOT** STAND.

From Barking Riverside. Proceed from Longbridge Road (circumnavigate roundabout at junction with Fanshawe Avenue) direct to stand. Set down on Longbridge Road at BUS STOP K.

Towards Barking Riverside. Depart via Longbridge Road to Station Parade. Pick up on Station Parade at BUS STOP H.

Turning point only. Blind display: BARKING.




CREEKMOUTH CURTAILMENT POINT

IMPORTANT PLEASE ENSURE YOU USE YOUR RIBAS KEY ON EVERY TRIP

From Little Heath. Proceed from Long Reach Road via Creek Road and Thames Road. Set down on Long Reach Road at **BUS STOP LONG REACH RD**.

Towards Little Heath. Depart to River Road. Pick up on River Road at *BUS STOP THAMES ROAD*.

Turning point only. Blind display: CREEKMOUTH.



From Little Heath. Proceed from Mallards Road direct to stand. Set down on Mallards Road at BUS STOP V.

Towards Little Heath. Depart to Mallards Road. Pick up on Marine Drive at *BUS STOP W*.

Public stand for two buses on west side of Mallards Road turning loop. **Blind display:** *BARKING RIVERSIDE, MALLARDS ROAD.*





SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILSTATTHE STAND

From Little Heath. Proceed from Northgate Road via Northgate Road Lay-By to stand. Set down on Northgate Road at BUS STOP NORTHGATE ROAD.

Towards Little Heath. Depart via Northgate Road lay-by to Northgate Road. Pick up on Northgate Road at BUS STOP NORTHGATE ROAD.

Private stand for two buses in lay-by adjacent to Northgate Road, approximately 150m south of junction with Choats Road. Selected school journeys only. Blind display: BARKING RIVERSIDE, NORTHGATE ROAD.



LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

5 MPH ZONE | NORTHGATE BUS STAND

Drivers and pedestrians in bus parking area as first bus stop is located here. 5 mph speed limit. Care and caution to be applied at all times whilst driving through the stand. Hi-vis to be worn outside of the vehicle.

BLIND BEND | GALLEONS DRIVE

Maintain low speed and plan ahead, looking for other buses and large vehicles.

SPEED HUMPS AND 20 MPH ZONE | MARINE DRIVE

Speed hump is high. Speed to be adhered to at all times. Care and caution.

VARIOUS HAZARDS THAMES ROAD

HGV's reversing, width restriction (priority going to little Heath), large speed humps on zebra crossings. Care and caution to be applied at all times, buses to slow as approaching width restriction and speed humps.

TIGHT TURN | RIVER RD / CREEK RD AND LONG REACH RD

Tight turns onto these side roads, risk of collision. Take wide on approach and watch for cyclists coming down on your inside as you take it wide.

BUSY JUNCTION | RIVER ROAD / A13 JUNCTION

Lanes merge into one lane, vehicles making illegal u-turns. Cycle lane. Extra care and caution to be taken. Advised to give cyclist a wide birth as road narrows.

PARK GATES | MOVERS LANE

Park gates open directly onto a zebra crossing. Drivers advised to slow down on approach and to be extra vigilant before proceeding across this zebra crossing.

TIGHT TURN | RIPPLE ROAD JUNC MOVERS LANE

Tight turn onto Movers Lane from Ripple Road. New zebra crossing installed just before turn, central reservation widened. Straddle both lanes on approach and watch for cyclists coming down on the inside as you take it wide.

BUSY SHOPPING AREA | VICARAGE FIELDS CENTRE

Pedestrian area with no kerbs. Extreme care and caution to be taken. 20 mph, but advisable to use a lower speed due to the high volume of pedestrians. Drivers be prepared to use horn to alert pedestrians to your presence.

LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

PARKED VEHICLES | VICARAGE FIELDS CENTRE

Vans parked unloading on market days. Appropriate speed on approach, caution advised surrounding mirror's, market traders walking out/opening doors into path of bus.

PEDESTRIAN AREA | BARKING STATION / STATION PARADE

Very busy station often people running for the bus or for the trains. Risk of collision with pedestrians if mirrors are not constantly checked before pulling away. Look out for pedestrians crossing in front of bus without looking, drop off's during rush hour, both mirrors to be checked before moving off.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | GREEN LANE / GOODMAYES LANE

Tight turn onto Goodmayes Lane from Green Lane, speed humps. Drivers advised to straddle both lanes on approach and watch for cyclists coming down on the inside and traffic on the left as you take it wide. Proceed slowly over speed humps for passenger comfort and safety.

VOLUME OF PEDESTRIANS | GOODMAYES STATION

Very busy station, often people running for the bus/trains. Risk of collision with pedestrians if mirrors are not constantly checked before pulling away. Check nearside before closing doors and to check both mirrors before pulling away.

EMERGENCY VEHICLES | KING GEORGE HOSPITAL

Take extra care and caution surrounding pedestrians and emergency vehicles, strict 5 mph speed limit must be adhered to. Risk of collision with pavement due to high kerb and tight turns. Lamp post. Take extra care and caution surrounding pedestrians and emergency vehicles, the stand is directly outside A&E, advised to check the n/s mirror as serving the bus stop due to lamp post close to the kerb.

TIGHT TURN | BARLEY LANE / CHADWELL HEATH LANE

Tight turn onto Chadwell Heath Lane from Barley Lane and also onto Little Heath. Front sweeps kerb to clear. Drivers advised to straddle both lanes on approach and watch for pedestrians walking on kerb that gets swept by front and traffic on the left as you take it wide.

FACILITIES | THROUGHOUT THE ROUTE

Barking Riverside. Toilet facilities available.

If you urgently need to use the following interim facility, please inform iBus first.

CODE RED | EMERGENCY RADIO PROCEDURE

If you require the Emergency Services to attend your vehicle (for example in the event of passenger injury, assault or major RTA), you should contact CentreComm using the radio's Code Red facility. To call CentreComm, hold down the Code Red button on your vehicle's radio for at least 3 seconds until you hear a ringing tone to indicate that your call has been connected. Hold down the foot switch in the cab when you are speaking, and end what you have to say with the word "over" to indicate that you expect a response, or "over and out" if this is the end of your communication. Release the foot switch when you are not speaking. Remember to speak slowly and clearly. Note that you will usually receive a radio call from your depot shortly after you make a Code Red call. You should not use the radio whilst the vehicle is in motion.

Call CentreComm for non-emergency, incident reporting or diversions



Call CentreComm for emergency services, passenger injury or assault



DON'T JUST DRIVE...

BEALERT AND BEAWARE OF LOW BRIDGES IN THE AREA



Never divert off route or light run unless authorised by iBus. **Anticipate and always remain alert.**
