4) OPERATIONAL CONSIDERATIONS


- 4.1) Route No. 70 should be separated from Route No. 7 between Wormwood Scrubs, Pavilion Hotel and Westbourne Park, Great Western Road during all periods, where possible.
- 4.2) When compiling schedules Tenderers are asked to consider passengers making connections to other services at the following locations: Acton Central Station, East Acton Station, Ladbroke Grove Station, Queensway Station and High Street Kensington Station.
- 4.3) Route No. 70 can suffer from unpredictable traffic delays in the Notting Hill Gate and Acton High Street areas.
- 4.4) The Notting Hill Carnival is an annual event held in the Notting Hill area over the late Summer Bank Holiday period and affects several LBSL contracted bus services. The arrangements for serving the area are flexible and depend on what advance information is provided by bodies such as the Metropolitan Police. Prior to the event, London Buses Officials will discuss service provision with those Operators who are involved.
- 4.5) Crossrail will connect the City, Canary Wharf, the West End and Heathrow Airport to commuter areas east and west of the capital. Major construction of the railway began in 2010, with services expected to commence in 2018. The construction impacts of Crossrail could affect Route No. 70 and it is anticipated that some passenger demand for Route No. 70 would shift to this line when it opens. Route No. 70 will be reviewed closer to the opening date
- 4.6) The 2012 Olympic Games open on Friday 27th July and close on Sunday 12th August. The 2012 Paralympic Games start on Wednesday 29th August and close on Sunday 9th September. The Games will result in additional passenger demand across the network, requiring additional capacity on some routes. There will also be a number of road closures in the event areas resulting in route diversions. Operators should be aware there will be implications to them during this time. Full details and any extra resource required will be negotiated with the operator at a later date.
