
## 4) OPERATIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

- 4.1) Route No. 90 should be separated from Route No. 490 between Hatton Cross and Feltham Station during all periods, where possible.
- 4.2) Route No. 90 should interwork with Route No. 285 between Hatton Cross and Feltham Station during Mondays to Saturdays daytimes and all evenings, and be separated during Sunday daytimes, where possible.
- 4.3) Route No. 90 should be separated from Route No. H98 between Hayes and Harlington Station and Harlington Corner during all periods, where possible.
- 4.4) Route No. 90 should be separated from Route No. 140 between Hayes and Harlington Station and Harlington Corner during all periods, where possible.
- 4.5) When compiling schedules Tenderers are asked to consider passengers making connections to other services at the following locations: Hayes and Harlington Station and Feltham Station.
- 4.6) Route No. 90 can suffer unpredictable traffic delays in the Hayes and Feltham areas.
- 4.7) Route No. 90 suffers from delays at Feltham, Leisure West on Friday and Saturday evenings, due to the popularity of the leisure complex at this location.
- 4.8) Crossrail will connect the City, Canary Wharf, the West End and Heathrow Airport to commuter areas east and west of the capital. Major construction of the railway began in 2010, with services expected to commence in 2018. The construction impacts of Crossrail could affect Route No. 90 and it is anticipated that some passenger demand for Route No. 90 would shift to this line when it opens. Route No. 90 will be reviewed closer to the opening date.
- 4.9) The 2012 Paralympic Games start on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> August and close on Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> September. The Games will result in additional passenger demand across the network, requiring additional capacity on some routes. There will also be a number of road closures in the event areas resulting in route diversions. Operators should be aware there will be implications to them during this time.


