1) NOTES

Proposed Changes:

At this time, the Corporation expects to implement a change to the existing service prior to the commencement of the new Route Agreement for Route No. 101.

On 16th April 2011, a reliability schedule is expected to be introduced. A bus will be removed during the Mondays to Fridays interpeak and the Saturday morning shopping period to eliminate surplus stand time. During the Mondays to Fridays PM peak and the Saturday afternoon shopping period, more running time is required. Cycle time will be redistributed to increase running time which will in turn eliminate the surplus stand time.

Tenderers should note that there are no changes proposed as part of this Service Specification for Route No. 101.


4) OPERATIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

- 4.1) Route No. 101 should interwork with Route No. 474 between Manor Park Station and Cyprus Station during all periods, where possible.
- 4.2) Route No. 101 should interwork with Route Nos. 104 & 238 between East Ham, Town Hall and East Ham Station during all evenings and Sundays and be best separated during all other periods, where possible.
- 4.3) Route No. 101 can suffer from unpredictable traffic delays in the East Ham area.
- 4.4) Football matches at West Ham United Football Club in Upton Park can cause severe traffic congestion in the area.
- 4.5) Route No. 101 operates via an area of major development with potentially thousands of new homes over the coming years (such as the Royal Quay, Royal Albert Basin and the Beckton Waterfront developments). The structure of the route will be reviewed as details of development come forward.
- 4.6) There are proposals for the reorganisation of acute health care provision in the boroughs of Newham and Redbridge. The locations of the new health care sites are not yet known. Changes in passenger demand will be assessed when details of the sites come forward.
- 4.7) Crossrail will connect the City, Canary Wharf, the West End and Heathrow Airport to commuter areas east and west of the capital. Major construction of the railway began this year, with services expected to commence in 2018. The construction impacts of Crossrail at Manor Park could affect Route No. 101 and it is anticipated that some passenger demand for Route No. 101 would shift to this line when it opens. Expected changes in demand as a result of Crossrail will be reviewed separately.
- 4.8) The 2012 Olympic Games open on Friday 27th July and close on Sunday 12th August. The 2012 Paralympic Games start on Wednesday 29th August and close on Sunday 9th September. The Games will result in additional passenger demand across the network, requiring additional capacity on some routes. There will also be a number of road closures in the event areas resulting in route diversions. Operators should be aware there will be implications to them during this time. Full details and any extra resource required will be negotiated with the operator at a later date.


