The successful Tenderer will be advised of the relevant local contacts for both London Buses' Network Operations and the Metropolitan Police. This can also cause traffic congestion in the area.
- 4.3) The Notting Hill Carnival is an annual event held in the Notting Hill area over the late Summer Bank Holiday period and affects several LBSL contracted bus services. The arrangements for serving the area are flexible and depend on what advance information is provided by bodies such as the Metropolitan Police. Prior to the event, London Buses Officials will discuss service provision with those Operators who are involved.
