Proposed Changes:

- 4.2) Route No. 294 should interwork with Route No. 175 between Collier Row Lane (at junction with Collier Row Road) and Romford Station during all periods.
- 4.3) Route No. 294 can suffer from unpredictable traffic delays in the Romford area, particularly during the Mondays to Fridays peak periods.
- 4.4) Romford Market, which is held on Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays can lead to traffic delays in the Romford area.
- 4.5) Crossrail will connect the City, Canary Wharf, the West End and Heathrow Airport to commuter areas east and west of the capital. Major construction of the railway began in 2010, with services expected to commence in 2018.
