Proposed Changes:

At this time, the Corporation expects to implement a change (subject to consultation) to the existing service prior to the commencement of the new Route Agreement for Route Nos. 345 & N345.

• From 3rd October 2015, in connection with the scheme to remove the gyratory at Stockwell and as part of the Road Modernisation Plan, buses are re-routed ex South Kensington, Cromwell Road via the bus only right turn from Clapham Road to Stockwell Road.

Tenderers should note that there are no changes proposed as part of this Service Specification for Route Nos. 345 & N345.
