2) NOTES

Proposed Changes:

At this time, the Corporation expects to implement a change to the existing service prior to the commencement of the new Route Agreement for Route No. 473.

- From 8th May 2012, Connaught Road has been closed northbound by Crossrail due to the need to demolish and replace the traffic and railway wall on the approach to the Connaught Road railway tunnel. Ex North Woolwich, Pier Road, buses are diverted from Albert Road via Link Road across former railway, Factory Road, North Woolwich Road, Connaught Bridge, Airport Roundabout and Connaught Road to Hartmann Road to re-join line of routeing As a result, stop 9527 on Albert Road is not served but stop BP5748 on Factory Road is being served. There is no change to the routeing ex Stratford Bus Station. This diversion will end on 26th October 2013.
- In order to facilitate Crossrail construction works at the North Woolwich tunnel portal, Albert Road has been closed eastbound from 29th September 2012. In order to continue serving North Woolwich in both directions, ex Stratford Bus Station, buses are diverted from Albert Road via Holt Road, Newland Street and Winifred Street to Albert Road to re-join line of routeing. As a result, two bus stops in Albert Road are served (9256 and 27913) but two stops on Newland Street are being served. There is no change to the routeing ex North Woolwich, Pier Road. This diversion will end on 20th December 2014.

Tenderers should note that the following alterations (subject to consultation) are proposed as part of this Service Specification for introduction with the new Route Agreement:

Crossrail diversions will end by 20th December 2014. It should be noted that Route No. 473 is subject to Crossrail diversions for approximately 9 months from the commencement of the new route agreement.

Two options are specified which would be subject to road works in the area and any changes arising from roadworks would be the subject of separate discussions:

Option 1:

No changes are proposed to frequencies and the current permanent structure.

Option 2:

- Route No. 473 is re-structured to operate between Gallions Reach, Shopping Park and Stratford Bus Station. Route No. 473 will operate from Gallions Reach Access Road, Armada Way, Atlantis Avenue, Gallions Roundabout and Woolwich Manor Way to Albert Way to re-join line of routeing. The section of Pier Road is withdrawn. Please see Section 5 for a full list of streets traversed and standing arrangements. This re-routeing is subject to a satisfactory route test.
- Departures ex Gallions Reach, Shopping Park are back projected from North Woolwich (Albert Way at junction with Pier Road).

- Tenderers should note that it is anticipated that the current DfT BSOG claims process will be discontinued for London contracts from 5th October 2013. Tender prices should therefore reflect this, however please continue to separately identify the fuel cost should the current BSOG process continue to apply after that date.

- 4.1) Route No. 473 should interwork with Route No. 262 between Plaistow, Greengate and Stratford Bus Station during all periods, where possible.
- 4.2) Route No. 473 should interwork with Route No. 474 between Gallions Roundabout and London City Airport during all evenings and Sundays and be best separated during other periods, where possible.
- 4.3) Route No. 473 can suffer from unpredictable traffic delays in the Plaistow and Stratford areas.
- 4.4) Delays can occur in North Woolwich caused by vehicles embarking and disembarking from the Woolwich ferry.
- 4.5) Home matches at West Ham United football club can lead to traffic delays in the surrounding areas.
- 4.6) Crossrail will connect the City, Canary Wharf, the West End and Heathrow Airport to commuter areas east and west of the capital. Major construction of the railway began in 2010, with services expected to commence in 2018. The construction impacts of Crossrail could affect Route No. 473 and it is anticipated that some passenger demand for Route No. 473 may shift to this line when it opens. Route No. 473 will be reviewed closer to the opening date.
