STREETS TRAVERSED

<u>Towards Hatton Cross Station:</u> Central Parade, Sparrow Farm Drive (Northern Section), Carlton Avenue, Service Road, Hounslow Road, Feltham High Street, Rochester Avenue, Granville Avenue, Guildford Avenue, Rosemead Avenue, Raleigh Road, Bedfont Road, Young Offenders Centre, Bedfont Road, Clockhouse Roundabout, Staines Road, Hatton Road, Fagg's Road, Hatton Road South, Hatton Cross, Southern Perimeter Road, Hatton Cross Bus Station.

Towards Feltham, Sparrow Farm: Hatton Cross Bus Station, Southern Perimeter Road, Hatton Cross, Hatton Road South, Fagg's Road, Hatton Road, Granville Avenue, Hatton Road, Staines Road, Clockhouse Roundabout, Bedfont Road, Young Offenders Centre, Bedfont Road, Raleigh Road, Rosemead Avenue, Guildford Avenue, Granville Avenue, Rochester Avenue, Feltham High Street, Hounslow Road, The Drive, Sparrow Farm Drive, Durham Road, Sparrow Farm Drive (Southern Section), Central Parade.

STANDING AND TURNING POINTS

FELTHAM, SPARROW FARM

Public stand for 2 buses in lay-by on west side of Central Parade opposite Sparrow Farm Residents Association Club between main arms of Sparrow Farm Drive and extending 18 metres south.

Buses proceed from Central Parade direct to stand, departing to Central Parade. Set down in Central Parade and pick up in Central Parade.

AVAILABILITY:

At any time.

OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:

No more than 1 bus on Route H26 should be scheduled

to stand at any one time.

MEAL RELIEFS:

No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.

FERRY VEHICLES:

No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.

DISPLAY:

Feltham, Sparrow Farm.

OTHER INFORMATION:

Hesitation point only, buses must not stand for longer than 2 minutes. Passengers can remain on board at

stand.

FELTHAM STATION (from HATTON CROSS STATION)

Private stand for 2 buses in lay-by on south side of New Road adjacent to north side of Feltham Station Forecourt and extending 16 metres east.

Buses proceed from Feltham High Street via Hounslow Road and New Road to stand, departing via New Road and Bedfont Lane to Feltham High Street. Set down in Feltham High Street, at Stop G and pick up in Feltham High Street, at Stop H.

AVAILABILITY: At any time.

OPERATING RESTRICTIONS: Unscheduled curtailments only.

MEAL RELIEFS: No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time. FERRY VEHICLES: No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.

DISPLAY: Feltham.

BEDFONT GREEN (from FELTHAM, SPARROW FARM)

Public stand for 2 buses on south side of slip road between Staines Road and Hatton Road on north side of Bedfont Green opposite St. Mary's Church and extending 19 metres east. Buses proceed from Staines Road via Slip Road to stand, departing via Slip Road to Hatton Road. Set down in Slip Road, on Stand and pick up in Hatton Road, at Stop T.

AVAILABILITY: At any time.

OPERATING RESTRICTIONS: Unscheduled curtailments only.

MEAL RELIEFS: No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time. FERRY VEHICLES: No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.

DISPLAY: Bedfont Green.

OTHER INFORMATION: To be used for unscheduled curtailments only.

HATTON CROSS BUS STATION

Private stand for 6 buses in marked bays on north side (4 buses) and in centre (2 buses) of Hatton Cross Bus Station on south side of Southern Perimeter Road.

Buses proceed from Hatton Cross Bus Station direct to stand, departing to Hatton Cross Bus Station. Set down in Hatton Cross Bus Station, at Alighting Point and pick up in Hatton Cross Bus Station, at Stop D.

AVAILABILITY: At any time.

OPERATING RESTRICTIONS: No more than 1 bus on Route H26 should be scheduled

to stand at any one time.

MEAL RELIEFS: No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.

FERRY VEHICLES: No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.

DISPLAY: Hatton Cross.
