Towards Trafalgar Square: Peckham Bus Station, Peckham High Street, Peckham Hill Street, Buller Close, Peckham Park Road, Old Kent Road, St James's Road, Rotherhithe New Road, Catlin Street, St James's Road, Southwark Park Road, Galleywall Road, Rotherhithe New Road, Rotherhithe Old Road, Lower Road, Surrey Quays Road, Canada Water Bus Station, Surrey Quays Road, Redriff Road, Salter Road, Brunel Road, St Olav's Square, Jamaica Road, Tooley Street, Duke Street Hill, Borough High Street, Southwark Street, Stamford Street, Waterloo Road, Tenison Way, York Road, Addington Street, Westminster Bridge Road, Westminster Bridge, Bridge Street, Bus-Only Right Turn, Parliament Street, Whitehall.

AUTHORISED STANDS, CURTAILMENT POINTS, & BLIND DESCRIPTIONS

Please note that only stands, curtailment points, & blind descriptions as detailed in this contractual document may be used.

PECKHAM BUS STATION

Private stand for up to 12 buses in Peckham Bus Station. Buses to stand abreast in 2 portions - 4 buses to stand facing east and 8 buses to stand facing south.

All buses must be fitted with an audible-reversing device.

Buses proceed from Peckham Bus Station direct to stand, departing to Peckham Bus Station. Set down in Peckham Bus Station, at Alighting Point (BP1344 - Peckham Bus Station, Last Stop on LOR: BP1344 - Peckham Bus Station) and pick up in Peckham Bus Station, at stop H (37419 - Peckham Bus Station, First Stop on LOR: 37419 - Peckham Bus Station).

AVAILABILITY: At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS: No more than 2 buses on Route N381 should be scheduled to stand at any one time.
MEAL RELIEFS: No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES: No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
BLIND DISPLAY: Peckham.

ROTHERHITHE TUNNEL, BRUNEL ROAD (from Peckham Bus Station)

Buses proceed from Brunel Road via St Olav's Square departing to Brunel Road. Set down in Brunel Road, at stop X (35900 - Rotherhithe Tunnel, Last Stop on LOR: 35900 - Rotherhithe Tunnel) and pick up in Brunel Road, at stop U (36732 - Rotherhithe Tunnel, First Stop on LOR: 36732 - Rotherhithe Tunnel).

AVAILABILITY: At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS: **Turning Point Only - Buses must not stand**
BLIND DISPLAY: Rotherhithe.

COUNTY HALL, YORK ROAD (from Peckham Bus Station)

Unmarked public stand for two Route 381 buses on west side of York Road outside County Hall North Block commencing prior to Bus Stop 4745 (F) and extending approximately 20 metres south towards Forum Magnum Square.

Buses proceed from York Road via Addington Street, Westminster Bridge Road, Bus-Only Slip Road and York Road to stand, departing to York Road. Set down in York Road, at stop G (4744 - County Hall, Last Stop on LOR: 4744 - County Hall) and pick up in York Road, at stop F (4745 - County Hall, First Stop on LOR: 4745 - County Hall).

AVAILABILITY: At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS: Unscheduled curtailments only.
MEAL RELIEFS: No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES: No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
BLIND DISPLAY: Waterloo.

TRAFALGAR SQUARE, NORTHUMBERLAND AVENUE, SOUTH SIDE

Public stand for four buses on south side of Northumberland Avenue in 2 parts:

1. For two buses commencing at a point 16 metres east of the centre-line of Great Scotland Yard, extending 25 metres east;
2. For two buses commencing at a point 55 metres west of centre-line of Whitehall Place, extending 25 metres east.

Buses proceed from Whitehall via Horse Guards Avenue, Victoria Embankment and Northumberland Avenue to stand, departing via Northumberland Avenue and Charing Cross to Whitehall. Set down in Whitehall (7867 - Horse Guards Parade, Last Stop on LOR: 7867 - Horse Guards Parade) and pick up in Whitehall, at stop P (14756 - Whitehall / Horseguards Avenue, First Stop on LOR: 14756 - Whitehall / Horseguards Avenue).

AVAILABILITY: At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS: No more than 1 bus on Route N381 should be scheduled to stand at any one time.
MEAL RELIEFS: No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES: No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
BLIND DISPLAY: Whitehall, Horse Guards.

STANDS, TURNING POINTS AND DESTINATION BLINDS

Tenderers should note that under normal circumstances, the specific restrictions relating to each stand will apply to the whole stand at all times. Any variation to such standing arrangements must be agreed by the Corporation. In addition, Tenderers should note the following general requirements:

- 6) Drivers MUST switch off engines during layover periods at bus stations or on stands.
- 7) No meal reliefs may be taken on any stand (on or off line of route) without the permission of the Corporation.
- 8) No crew ferry vehicles may enter any stand (on or off line of route) without the permission of the Corporation.
- 9) Destination blind displays to be used are shown under each stand description. Tenderers may suggest, within their bids, alternative blind displays.
- 10) The intermediate (also known as via) blind display to be used on the nearside of the vehicle is shown in the box below:

PECKHAM BUS STATION

Private stand in Peckham Bus Station.

Buses proceed from Peckham Bus Station direct to stand, departing to Peckham Bus Station. Set down in Peckham Bus Station, at Alighting Point and pick up in Peckham Bus Station, at Stop H.

AVAILABILITY:	At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	No more than 2 vehicles on Route No. N381 should be scheduled to stand at any one time.
MEAL RELIEFS:	No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES:	No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
OTHER INFORMATION:	LBSL toilet facilities available 24 hours daily.
DISPLAY:	Peckham

ROTHERHITHE TUNNEL, BRUNEL ROAD (from Peckham Bus Station)

Private stand in bay on south side of Brunel Road, commencing 35 metres west of Rupack Street and extending 27 metres east.

Buses proceed from Brunel Road direct to stand, departing via Brunel Road and St Olav's Square to Brunel Road. Set down in Brunel Road, at Stop X and pick up in Brunel Road, at Stop U.

AVAILABILITY:	At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	Unscheduled curtailments only.
MEAL RELIEFS:	No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES:	No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
DISPLAY:	Rotherhithe

WATERLOO, COUNTY HALL (from Peckham Bus Station)

Public stand on west side of York Road, commencing at the lamp standard 19 metres north of the subway steps and extending 19 metres south.

Buses proceed from York Road via Addington Street, Westminster Bridge Road and York Road to stand, departing to York Road. Set down in York Road, at Stop G and pick up in York Road, at Stop F.

AVAILABILITY:	At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	Unscheduled curtailments only.
MEAL RELIEFS:	No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES:	No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
DISPLAY:	Waterloo

TRAFALGAR SQUARE, NORTHUMBERLAND AVENUE

Public stand on south side of Northumberland Avenue in 2 parts:

1. From a point 16 metres east of the centre-line of Great Scotland Yard, extending 25 metres east;
2. From a point 55 metres west of centre-line of Whitehall Place, extending 25 metres east.

Buses proceed from Whitehall via Whitehall Place and Northumberland Avenue to stand, departing via Northumberland Avenue and Charing Cross to Whitehall. Set down in Whitehall and pick up in Whitehall, at Stop P.

AVAILABILITY:	At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	No more than 1 vehicle on Route No. N381 should be scheduled to stand at any one time.
MEAL RELIEFS:	No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES:	No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
OTHER INFORMATION:	National Rail toilet facilities available 24 hours daily.
DISPLAY:	Trafalgar Square
